We encourage meeting attendees to stay at the Asilomar Conference Grounds. Please reserve your lodging directly with Asilomar using the form on the conference website. The deadline for room reservations is **May 18, 2007**. All meals are included with lodging at Asilomar. If you choose not to stay at Asilomar, you will be charged a \$25 per day use fee (in addition to the registration). Because Asilomar is a California State Park, the \$25 per day fee is charged to cover a park entrance fee and lunch. The per day use fees will be collected upon your arrival at Asilomar at the conference registration desk.

Please submit your abstract for a paper or a poster as soon as possible to Dave Rizzo at dmrizzo@ucdavis.edu. The deadline for submission has been extended to **Monday, April 16, 2007**.
