### Student Responsibilities for Completion of the CNR Honors Program

- Write your research proposal according to the guidelines specified on the back of this enrollment form.
- Identify a faculty member to serve as your research mentor. If you choose to work with a faculty member outside of CNR, you must also identify a faculty sponsor in your home department in CNR. If your research mentor is a CNR faculty member, you do not need to find an additional sponsor.
- Completion of two departmental H196 courses (8 units total) with your faculty mentor is required. Each unit represents three hours of research conducted per week.
- You must enroll in each of the 4-unit H196 courses for a letter grade and earn a grade of B or better while maintaining a minimum overall GPA of 3.60 through graduation.
- Attend mandatory meeting the beginning of each semester.
- Participation in a CNR Honors Symposium, an oral presentation, is required. The symposium is held near the end of each fall and spring semester. A 1 page summary is due on the day of the oral presentation.
- At the conclusion of your participation in the CNR Honors Program, you must submit an honors research thesis paper to your faculty research mentor. Thesis format will conform to the expectations for submission of a "publishable" paper to the relevant research discipline.
