Requirements for Enrollment in the CNR Honors Program

1. Submit your research proposal and honors enrollment form: Attach an additional sheet detailing your research proposal, which should include the following:

Students are strongly encouraged to attend a research workshop offered by the Office of Undergraduate Research for proposal writing guidelines. See research.berkeley.edu. Sample completed theses are available at the CNR front desk.

2. Identify a faculty member to serve as your research mentor: If you choose to work with a faculty member outside of CNR, you must also identify a faculty sponsor in CNR. If your research mentor is a CNR faculty member, you do not need to find an additional sponsor. Environmental Sciences students are required to obtain the signature of an ESPM 175 instructor in addition to their research mentor (if they are different).

Requirements for Completion of the CNR Honors Program

a. Complete 8 units of departmental honors courses with your faculty mentor: You will enroll in a four-unit H196 course for two consecutive semesters. Environmental Sciences students will enroll in ESPM H175A and H175L in the Fall, and ESPM H175B and H175L in the Spring. Four units represent twelve hours of research conducted per week. Honors courses must be taken for a letter grade and students must earn a grade of B or better each semester.

b. Maintain a minimum overall UC GPA of 3.6 through graduation.

c. Participate in the CNR Honors Symposium: An oral presentation at the end of your 2nd semester is **required**. The Honors Symposium is held during RRR week, typically Thursday and Friday. Environmental Sciences students are also required to present at the ES Senior Symposium in April.

d. Submit an honors research thesis paper to your faculty research mentor. At the conclusion of your participation in the CNR Honors Program, you must submit an honors research thesis paper to your faculty research mentor. Thesis format will conform to the expectations for submission of a “publishable” paper to the relevant research discipline, in accordance to the guidelines established by your faculty research mentor.
