

Reasons for non-use of contraception in Sub-Saharan Africa




Cultural Barrier: Lack of Access













Cultural Barrier: Concerned About Health Effects






Cultural Barrier: Opposed to Use (Religious, Personal, husband)






Cultural Barrier: Wants as Many Children as Possible






Cultural Barrier: Fear of Side Effects











